



YOUTH EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

The Thaidene Nëné Department is hiring **six (6) summer students**. The summer students will work alongside the Ni Hat'ni Dene guardians. These positions are located in Łutsël K'é.

Responsibilities will include, but are not limited to:

- Monitoring water quality, fish, and other wildlife within the Thaidene Nëné Indigenous Protected Area.
- Acting as ambassadors for Thaidene Nëné, and welcoming and engaging visitors in the Indigenous protected area.
- Providing orientation, information, and interpretation on the natural and cultural history of Łutsël K'é Dene lands.
- Delivering visitor surveys.
- Welcoming visitors to Łutsël K'é, Kaché, and the Ni Hat'ni Dene cabins.
- Taking care of the old village at Kaché (includes maintaining cabins, cleaning up garbage, and cutting wood).
- Maintaining records of activities and travel routes.

Qualifications:

- Must be a youth (15-30 years old).
- Ability to work as part of a team.
- Good communication skills.
- Experience working with youth and children.
- Must be physically fit.
- Knowledge of LKDFN natural and cultural heritage is an asset.
- Ability to speak and/or understand the Dënesyliné language is an asset.
- Experience operating boats is an asset.
