
A reminder to hunters to follow respectful hunting laws and protocols.



Respectful Hunting Laws

- Do not hunt retthën (caribou) from the Bathurst herd.
- Hunters are encouraged to respectfully hunt retthën from other herds, and other animals that are more abundant.
- Do not hunt calves or pregnant females from any herd.
- LKDFN hunters are required to report all harvests to WLED.
- Non-LKDFN hunters are asked to notify WLED before coming to our territory to hunt.

Respectful Hunting Protocols

- Take youth hunting.
- Do not consume alcohol or drugs.
- Do not chase retthën.
- Only hunt the number of petthen you need and can cut up and transport in your sled.
- Take all meat.
- Move remains into the bush.
- Clean up, burn, or pack out garbage.
- Share meat and usable parts with Elders and those in need.
